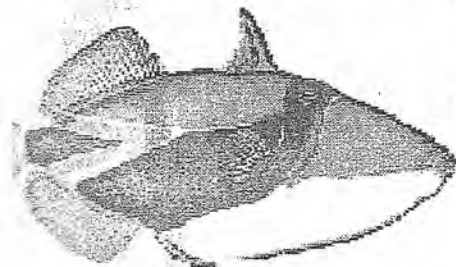
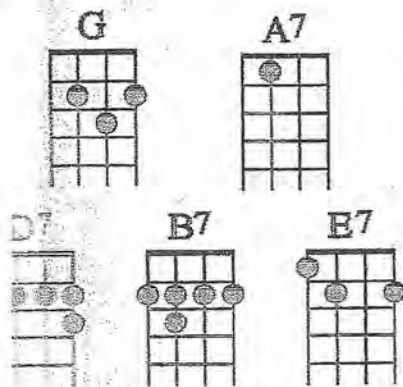


# My Little Grass Shack
