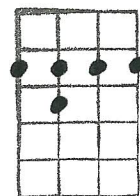
G E7 Am D / G / D7--

2. If I never had a cent, I'd be as rich as Rockefeller,

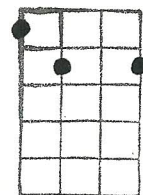
G E7 Am D E7
